4. Develop leadership development skills such as writing journal articles and grants, managing grants, developing teams and sharing a vision, discussing research and policy with policymakers, public speaking, searching successfully for positions, navigating the world of academe as a junior faculty member and getting tenure, leading a research, program or policy organization.
